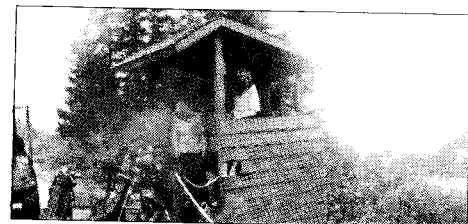
# JOHN FRASER FALL CLASSIC
